Job Title: **Portage Aquatics Lead** Pay Rate: **\$14.00 - \$16.00 Per Hour** Program Hours: **Full-Time Summer Seasonal Position**

POSITION SUMMARY:

The Portage Aquatics Lead is responsible for the daily operations of the pool. Working closely with the Portage Aquatics Director and Association Aquatics Director, the Portage Aquatics Lead also focuses on member service, program quality, and staff development.

Serves as a general resource to the branch in the areas of Aquatics.

Demonstrate the Y's core values of INTEGRITY, HEALTH, DIVERSITY and COLLABORATION.

ESSENTIAL FUNCTIONS:

- 1. Provide leadership and direction to Lifeguards, Swim Instructors, and Water Exercise Instructors.
- 2. Ensure that the poos and related equipment are properly cleaned and maintained, with a focus on safety and function.
- 3. Manage schedules as needed, assist Portage Aquatics Director with scheduling, payroll administration, and swim lesson registration.
- 4. Build relationship with members so that they develop a long lasting relationship with the YMCA.
- 5. Participate in departmental Level 10 and/or other related meetings as required.
- 6. Assist in member retention strategies and sales initiatives (private lessons).
- 7. Collaborate with staff across all departments to achieve association goals and initiatives.
- 8. Assist with staff recruitment and training.

QUALIFICATIONS:

- 1. BS/BA degree or equivalent in work experience.
- 2. Two or more years' experience in Aquatics, preferably in a YMCA.
- 3. Familiarity with YMCA swim lesson class levels.
- 4. Strong leadership and organizational skills; strong written, verbal and presentation skills are a must.
- 5. Lifeguard, CPR/AED and First Aid certifications.
- 6. Must be able to assume duties of lifeguards, supervisors, instructors, and assist with handling of pool emergencies.
- 7. Must be able to stand for extended periods of time as well as squat, stoop, or bend into awkward positions. Must be able to lift and carry items up to 30 pounds.
- 8. Computer and technology proficient: MS Office applications, database usage, and mobile phone apps. Membership (Daxko) software proficiency a plus.
