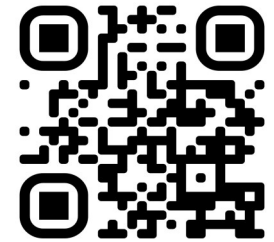

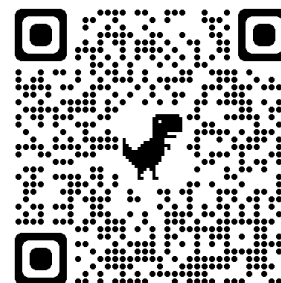
Did you know that the YMCA is a non-profit organization that relies on donations in order to fulfill its mission?
